

This bursary is worth £5,700 over the period of three years. The first year is worth £3,000, the second and third year are worth £1,350 per academic year; provided each year is passed and progressed. The Bursary can be awarded as cash or flexible* payments.

* Flexible payment can be a payment for accommodation, tuition fee discount or childcare.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Full time Home students, normally resident in the UK
- Students 25 or under, who are currently open to and supported by a local authority leaving care service
- Enrolled on a full time BA/BSc degree course, including NHS funded; excluding Foundation level
- Paying the maximum tuition fee of £9,250

Scholarships & Bursaries 2022/23

Important Information

To continue to receive scholarships and bursaries students eligible for University funding must progress onto the next level of study and maintain appropriate standards of behaviour. Students can only receive one scholarship or bursary, which will be the one that has the highest monetary value.

Merit Scholarship

Once registered with the University and providing you meet the eligibility criteria* with an entry qualification of 112 UCAS tariff points or more (or equivalent), you will be awarded the Merit Scholarship worth £2,400 over three academic years. This scholarship is paid in three instalments over the year.

The Bursary

Once registered with the University and providing you meet the eligibility criteria* with an entry qualification of fewer than 112 UCAS tariff points (or equivalent), you will be awarded the Bursary worth £1,500 over three academic years. This bursary is paid in two instalments over the year.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Full time Home student
- Be a new entrant from February 2022 or academic year 2022/23 (not previously registered)
- Paying the maximum tuition fee of £9,250
- Year 1 of an undergraduate degree, including SLC and NHS funded

Application Process

- No application required
- Eligible students will be awarded automatically
- Eligible students will be contacted via email

Level 5 Bursary

Once registered with the University, and providing you meet the eligibility criteria, you will be awarded the Level 5 Bursary worth £500 per academic year, up to a maximum of two years. This bursary is paid in two instalments over the year.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Full time Home student
- Be a new entrant from September 2022 for the 2022/23 academic year (not previously registered)
- Paying the relevant maximum tuition fee of £9,250
- Level 5 (year 2) of an undergraduate degree, including SLC and NHS funded
